### Class Size

The average class size is 12 students. Each class has a teacher’s aide.

### Age Requirement

Preschool children must be four-years-old by October 1 of the school year they enter Trinity.

Area of Curriculum	Skill or Activity
<b>Bible</b>	Listening to stories of major characters of the Bible. Scripture integration through all disciplines. Scripture memory.
<b>Literature and Language Development</b>	Enjoying fairy tales, nursery rhymes, poetry, and quality children’s literature. Dramatic play.
<b>Writing</b>	Practicing good habits for prewriting skills: correct posture, pencil grip, large and fine motor development of arms/hands/fingers.
<b>Mathematics</b>	Recognizing and working with shapes. Simple counting. Directional words.
<b>Science</b>	Exploring nature. Learning about animals and animal homes. Seasonal studies.
<b>Geography</b>	Identifying own city and state. Introduction of geographical terms.
<b>History</b>	Listening to stories of famous Americans, missionaries, historical figures.
<b>Art</b>	Recognizing color in God’s creation. Encouraging creativity and imagination through art media.
<b>Music</b>	Singing, learning hymns, rhythm activities, movement exploration, listening skills
<b>Physical Activity</b>	Developing gross motor skills through free play and organized games and exercise.
